CFRE Review Class

Individuals interested in the Certified Fund Raising Executive (CFRE) designation must have at least five years of paid, professional practice in fundraising, meet all of the minimum eligibility requirements, and pass an extensive multiple choice exam. Detailed information can be obtained at the CFRE website www.cfre.org where individuals can complete the application online, and learn more about the test and other criteria. There are 4 major competency areas that are evaluated for eligibility: Education, Professional Practice, Professional Performance and Service.

Once you have met these requirements, you will apply for approval to sit for the exam. This CFRE Review class is an intensive 2 day session that will equip you with the information you need to know in order to pass the exam.
